ABOUT GOVERNMENT MODEL COLLEGE, KAZIRANGA

Government Model College, Kaziranga which has been initiated by the Government of Assam as a premier institution was established at Kaziranga, the world famous place of UNESCO natural heritage site as well as the World iconic place for promoting higher education across the country in the month of August, 2020. Since then the college is known as Government Model College, Kaziranga and now onwards coined as GMCK with a distinct identity and considered as new Government College. The college is located at 26.60344⁰ latitude and 93.41323⁰ longitudes. The campus of the college is around 300m away from 37 No. National Highway and is located 4 km away from Kohora, the centre place of the Kaziranga National Park. On the other, it is situated approx 226 KM west of Gauhati University > 221 KM east of Dibrugarh University, 226 KM South of Assam University Silchar while 222 KM to Madhabdev University and close to Tezpur Central University ~100 K.M. Well connected to the rest of the country by roadways, railways, and airways it serves as a gateway to eastern Assam. The college is well-connected from different directions of the state via roadways, railways as well as airways. Buses, cars and other vehicles are available connecting the road to college in all weather. The nearest railway stations of the college are Furkating junction, Golaghat and Jakhalabandha under Noagaon district. The neighbouring air connectivity to the college lies at Jorhat, Dimapur, Tezpur and Guwahati.

The college is enriched with its vast resources of flora and fauna and especially for its surrounding tea plantations. Presently the college has 7 departments with 21 faculties and one librarian. Currently, the college has one RCC building with the ground floor and four half-walled buildings to run the classes. With the basic aim of promoting higher education in the state of Assam specifically among the surrounding population of Kaziranga; the GMCK is always striving to fulfil the dreams of every student. In addition, the college is also in the verge of introducing modern innovative techniques for imparting quality education. With renewed attention towards both infrastructural and academic development, the college has proposed the introduction of Science and Commerce streams very soon in aligning with National Education Policy 2020. 1. Submission of forms for H.S. programme shall exclusively be online.

2. Aspiring candidates for H.S admission shall have to open and go through the DARPAN portal only.

3. All scanned documents (mark sheets, certificates, photographs, signature etc.) must be uploaded to the portal conforming to the size and type specified in the instructions.

4. All applicants must provide a valid personal email ID and active/valid mobile number(s).

5. The profile of a student can be edited only once before verification of the applications by the college.

6. The published selection list and waiting list for admission into HS First Year will be made available in the DARPAN portal for students.

7. After publication of selection list, students are advised to accept admission offered by the college for admission using their login ID in the portal at the earliest. After approval, the students must take admission in the institution concerned within the stipulated time period to complete the admission process.

8. Students will be allowed to change their preferred subjects at the time of admission into HS 1st year and the college will update the same in the portal on the day of admission.

1. Admission into Four Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) shall be conducted through the SAMARTH Portal only (visit <u>www.assamadmission.samarth.ac.in</u>).

2. Candidate has to apply for Admission into Four Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) through SAMARTH

3. After the closing of application in SAMARTH, the college will publish the 1st Merit List

4. Subsequently, the college will conduct Offline Admission in 1st Merit List.

5. On the closing of Admission in 1st Merit List, the college will publish a 2nd Merit List and will conduct Offline Admission in 2nd Merit List.

6. On the closing of Offline Admission in 2^{nd} Merit List, the college will publish a 3^{rd} Merit List and will conduct offline Admission in 3^{rd} Merit List.

7. The college will conduct Spot Admission (Offline) after exhaustion of 3rd merit list on the specified date/dates.

8. At the time of Offline admission the students must bring with them all their required documents [original and photocopies], along with a printed copy of their application form.

- ➢ As per AHSEC, a student must have a minimum of 75% attendance in H.S. classes to appear in respective examination.
- The degree course offered as per Dibrugarh University (D.U.) Four Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP); a student must have a minimum of 80% of attendance; failing which a student will not be eligible to appear in the examination.
- Information/intimation to the respective teachers is essential for students not able to attend their classes due to various personal or exigent in nature. In any situation and circumstances, the authority decision will be final in granting of absence.
- ➢ For medical leave, the medical Certificate should be enclosed along with the leave application signed by the parent/local guardian.
- For students participating in Sports/Cultural events during a Semester; have to intimate the concerned Department Head/Authority and take permission before proceeding to participate.
- Malpractice in any examination including test is strictly prohibited and may be punishable if recurring in nature.

- All candidates must be present in the Examination Hall at least 15 minutes ahead of scheduled examination time.
